Covid

Unfortunately, Covid is still present within our community, and its spread is likely to increase over the coming winter months. We have already had a number of cases at Buick! We will be following the Public Health / NI Direct Guidance which states:


If you have a positive COVID-19 test result, you should follow the advice: stay at home and avoid contact with other people for five days (or three days for children and young people under 18 years of age) after the day of the test, or from the day symptoms started (whichever was earlier)

- avoid contact with people you know to be at higher risk from COVID-19 for 10 days especially those
 with a weakened immune system
- do not visit others in a health or social care setting for 10 days
- continue to take precautions, such as regularly washing your hands and wearing a face mask, particularly in crowded indoor places
- let everyone in your household and anyone with whom you have had close contact, know that you have Covid.

Class of The Week - P4/3GM

All the children in P4/3 have settled in well to their new class rules and routines. This week, they have been focusing on Active Learning during Numeracy lessons. Our aim is to make Maths more engaging!

The pupils used a variety of Numeracy resources such as STILE, Numicon and 'Make 4' board games to consolidate their written classwork. The children have found this approach fun and it has strengthened their understanding of mathematical concepts.

Applying for... Free School Meals & Uniform Allowance

1. Are you eligible?



You must be:

- in receipt of a qualifying benefit
- be an Asylum Seeker supported by the Home Office Asylum Support Assessment Team

Qualifying Benefits:

- Income Support;Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance;
- Income Related Employment and Support
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit;
- Child Tax Credit or Working Tax Credit with an annual taxable household income of £16,190 or
- Universal credit and have net household earnings not exceeding £14,000 per year.

2. What documentation do you need?

You will be asked to upload proof that you are receiving a qualifying benefit:

- Tax Credits Award Notice
- Universal Credit Payments breakdown or
- Proof of Benefit letter (if you are in receipt of Income Support, Income Based Jobseeker's Allowance, Income Related Employment and Support Allowance or the Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit).





3. What else do you need?

- National Insurance Number
- Dates of Birth
- · Schools they will be attending

- E-mail and telephone number
- Bank or building society account and sort code details.

4. Where do you apply?

Visit the EA's Free School Meals and Uniforms page to start an application. As well as new applicants, parents/guardians who are currently in receipt of Free School Meals & Uniform Allowance will need to apply again for this year, You will need to register with an e-mail address and create an account to apply. You will then be able to log back in to check your application




5. What happens next?



Your application will be processed within 3 weeks, Please do not contact EA for an update on your application within the 3 weeks of submitting your application. If you have provided incorrect or insufficient supporting documentation, you will receive a tailored email advising you to resubmit your application with details of the correct documentation you need to
