

Our pupils have been practising their words and songs in school and at home. Thank you for supporting this initiative and providing clothes/costumes, as required.

We would like to invite parents and family members to attend these performances. In order to comply with Health and Safety requirements, we can accommodate a maximum of 3 family members per pupil. All attendees will pay £4 entry fee at the door. The proceeds from the two performances will go towards School Funds, which facilitates additional opportunities for our children. We respectfully ask that our pupils are given optimum conditions to perform and that younger babies/toddlers are not brought along to the performances. We cannot accommodate buggies or prams due to Health and Safety requirements. Thank you in advance for your support in these matters.

It has been a long standing tradition at Buick, that all children finish early on this day (12:15pm). Parents will be able to take their child (P1-P3) following their performance. If parents wish to take other siblings at the same time, please telephone the office in advance and we will prepare family members and their class teachers accordingly. All pupils P4-P7 will finish at 12:15pm. Please note, there will be no buses in the afternoon.

Our Annual Carol Service will take place on Tuesday 12th December in Cuningham Memorial Church. Families and friends are welcome to join us in the church at 10am. Our P2-P7 children will be attending this service. An offering will be taken during the service for 'Ballymena's 'Jingle All the Way' charity.

On Friday 15th December, the school will finish early at 1pm to allow our Nursery and P1 Open Afternoon to take place for prospective Nursery and P1 pupils and parents. Places for this event can be booked via the school office.
