Breakfast Club

Have you availed of our Breakfast Club this term? This additional facility is designed to help with childcare arrangements for parents. Our gates at the back of the school open at 8am and staff are present until 8:10am. Pupils are then escorted to the Dining Centre where they can purchase a range of breakfast foods and participate in a number of activities before school starts. This service costs £1 and we would like to see more pupils attending to ultimately secure the provision.



Building Works at Buick

As you already aware, our Outdoor Learning Area at the Nursery, is slowly nearing completion! Likewise, the Assembly Hall has been redecorated and we are excited about the new screen and projector being installed in December. 
