### BBC Filming

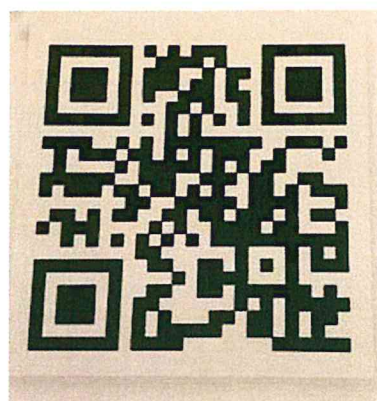
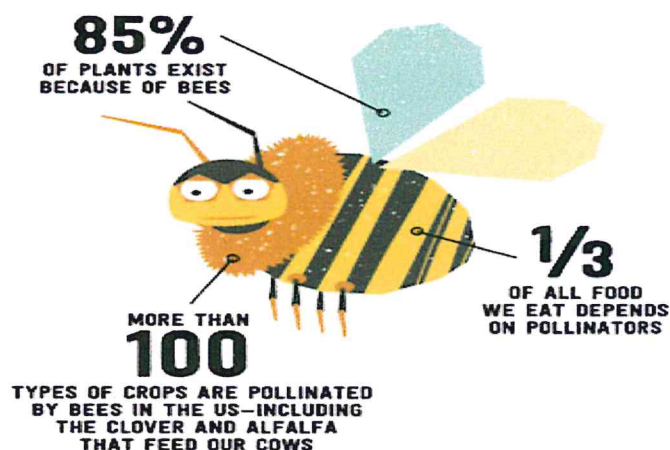
Thank you to all parents who have already returned the consent forms for 'A Carryin Stream'. Unfortunately, pupils cannot participate in the programme without this permission.
